YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT THE FOLLOWING CHANGES IN THE RED CLIFF CODE OF LAWS HAS BEEN PROPOSED TO THE TRIBAL COUNCIL BY THE RED CLIFF FISHERIES DEPARTMENT:

### **PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 7 -- COMMERCIAL FISHING REGULATIONS SECTION 7.11 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

ADDITIONS ARE INDICATED AS **BOLD** AND *ITALICIZED*

**ADD**            **7.11.1 (d) which shall read as follows:**

**7.11**            **SECTION 11: REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

**7.11.1**        All commercial fishers shall file reports on the first and fifteenth of the month. (6/2/14) (11/20/18)

*(d) Commercial fishermen shall complete a Fish Disposition Report on forms supplied by the Red Cliff Fisheries Department. The report shall contain the following information: disposition of all catch by day, to whom the fish was acquired by or sold to, the amount of weight in pounds, the species of fish and its condition at the time of the transaction. This shall include all transactions, including multiple transactions to the same person or retailer on the same day. This shall also include any fish sold directly to consumers and any fish retained by commercial fishermen for sale in their own retail business. The reports shall follow due date requirements stated RCCL 7.11.1 and may be included as an insert to catch reports defined in sub. (a).*

THIS PROPOSAL WILL BE VOTED UPON ON **TUESDAY APRIL 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019** AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE RED CLIFF TRIBAL COUNCIL. IF THE COUNCIL ENACTS THIS CODE CHANGE, THE CODE CHANGE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON: **upon enactment.**
