

NOTICE

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT THE FOLLOWING CHANGES IN THE RED CLIFF CODE OF LAWS HAS BEEN PROPOSED TO THE TRIBAL COUNCIL:

PERTAINING TO CHAPTER 11 – LOGGING, BURNING AND WOODCUTTING

CHANGES AND ADDITIONS ARE INDICATED AS **BOLD** AND *ITALICIZED*
DELETIONS ARE INDICATED WITH ~~STRIKETHROUGHS~~.

Amend sections 11.1 and 11.4.2 as follows:

11.1 **SECTION 1: COMMERCIAL LOGGING**

No commercial logging operation shall be carried on within the exterior boundaries of the Reservation unless the logger shall hold a Commercial Logging Permit. Commercial Logging permits shall be issued by the ~~Environmental Office~~ *Forestry and Wildlife Department* upon Tribal Council approval using the PAC approval process set forth in RCCL Chapter 37.

11.4.2 The ~~Environmental Office~~ *Forestry and Wildlife Department* shall issue tribal Woodcutting Permits, only to members for home use.

Add **SECTION 5: BAN ON OUTSIDE FIREWOOD** which shall read as follows:

11.5 SECTION 5: BAN ON OUTSIDE FIREWOOD

11.5.1 No firewood or timber with bark intact shall be transported to or through the reservation from a distance of greater than 25 miles, except pursuant to a permit issued by the Forestry and Wildlife Department. This provision includes, but is not limited to, campfires, business and industrial use, or firewood used to heat the home.

11.5.2 Anyone who violates 11.5.1 shall have their wood confiscated and may be assessed a fine between \$50 - \$250. Each subsequent day the violation occurs is subject to additional fines.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON THIS PROPOSAL IS ENCOURAGED. PLEASE DROP YOUR COMMENTS AT THE TRIBAL ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, OR FORWARD THEM DIRECTLY TO THE TRIBAL COUNCIL. THIS PROPOSAL WILL BE VOTED UPON ON **Monday July 1st, 2013** AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE RED CLIFF TRIBAL COUNCIL. IF THE COUNCIL ENACTS THIS CODE CHANGE, THE CODE CHANGE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON **upon**

enactment. ADDITIONAL COPIES OF THIS PROPOSAL MAY BE OBTAINED AT THE RED CLIFF LEGAL DEPARTMENT.
